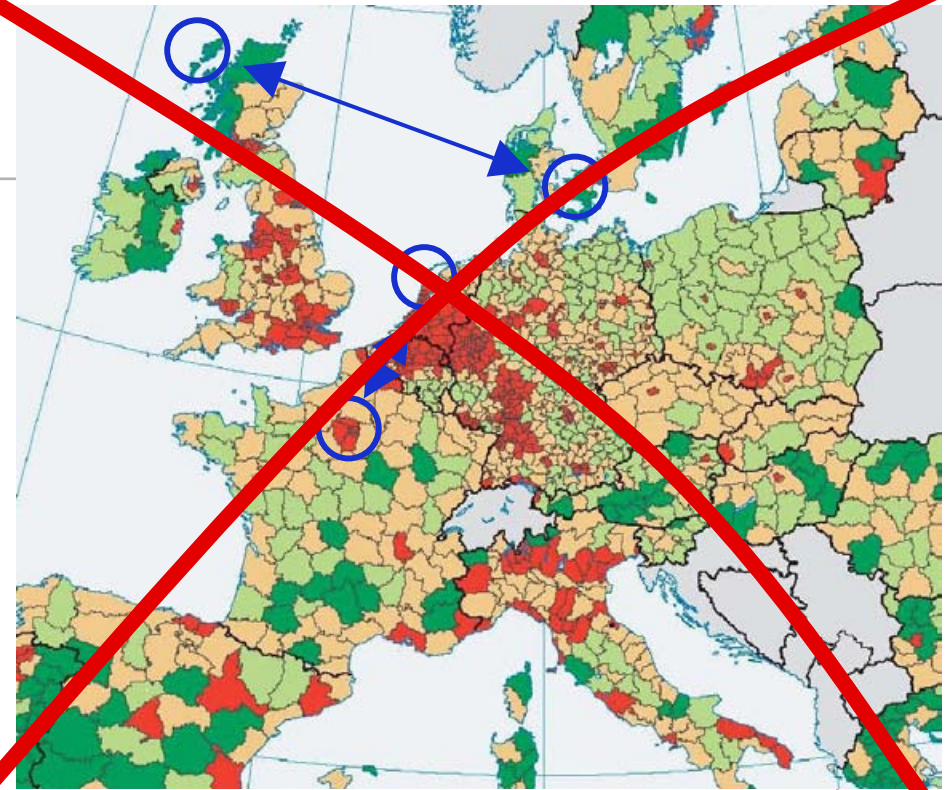

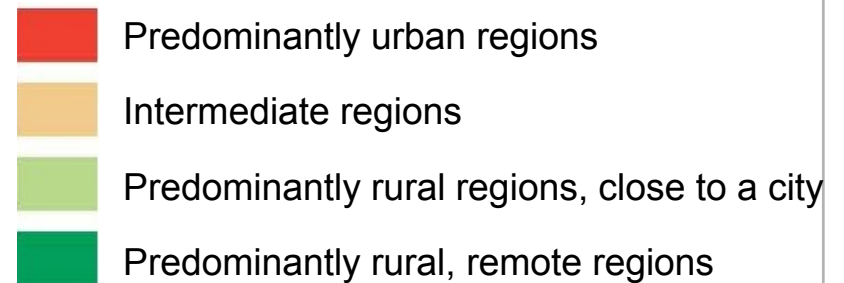
A differentiated view?

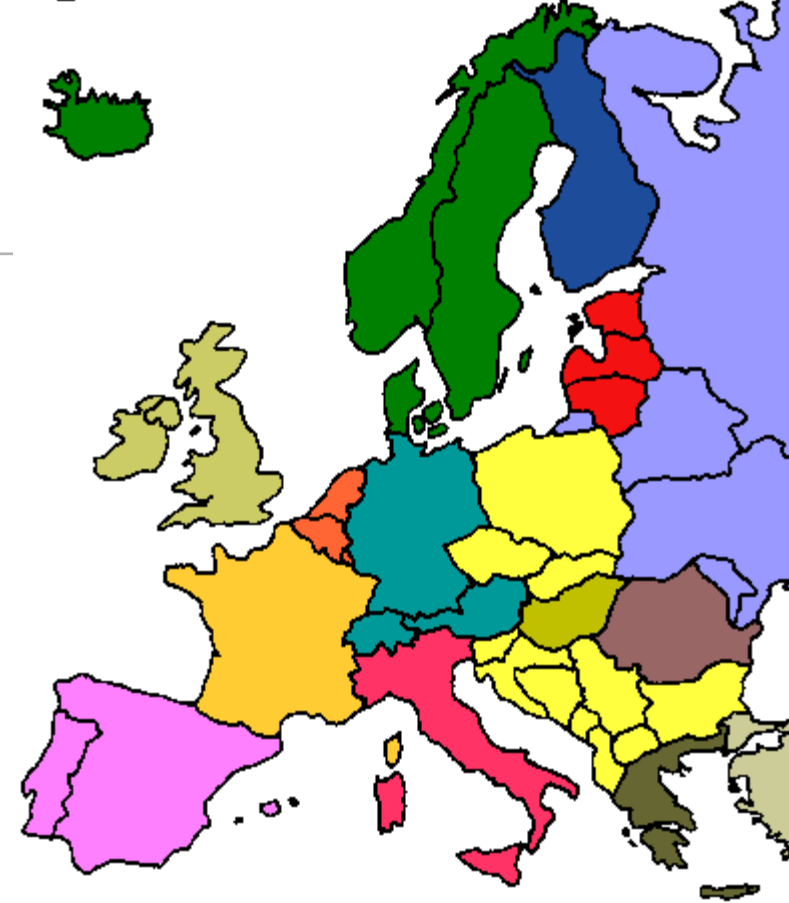

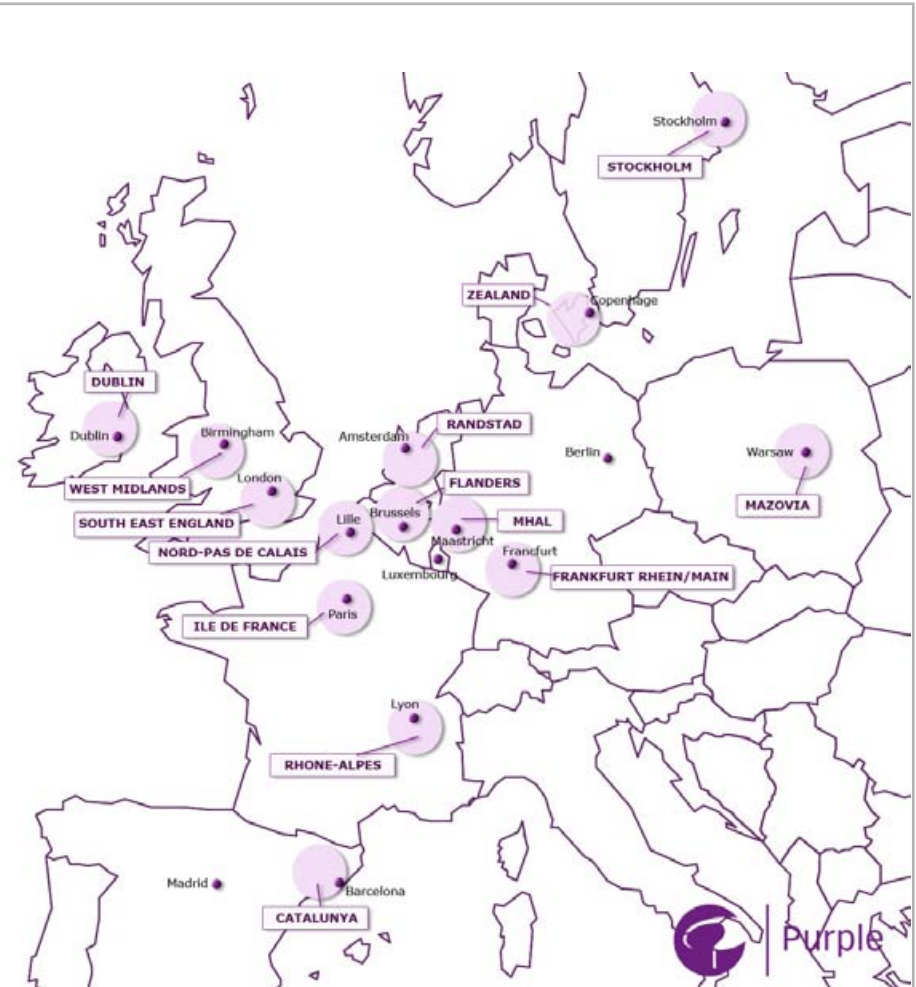
